WAGE:

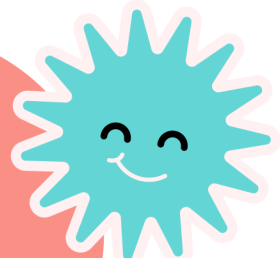

The median annual wage for audiologists was \$82,680 in May 2022.
