School Counselors are vital members of the educational team; collaborate with teachers, school staff, administrators, and families to support student success; help students understand and overcome social and behavioral challenges; advise individuals and small groups based on their needs; help students develop academic and social skills and plans for after graduation.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's degree in school counseling
- Must meet state certification/licensure requirements

WAGE:

The median annual wage for school and career counselors and advisors was \$60,140 in May 2022.

JOB OUTLOOK:

Employment of school and career counselors and advisors is projected to grow 5% percent from 2022 to 2032, faster than the average for all occupations.
