
SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST:

School Psychologists consult with teachers, families, and other school-employed mental health professionals (i.e., school counselors, school social workers) and other school-based professionals to suggest improvements to teaching, learning and administrative strategies 

SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS

Apply psychological principles and techniques to education disorders and developmental disorders. They may address student learning and behavioral problems; design and implement performance plans, and evaluate performances; and counsel students and families 

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A master's degree plus an education specialist degree (Ed.S.) are required in Nevada schools; Ed.D. or Ph.D. preferred
- To qualify for national certification, a school psychologist must meet the established standards of the National Association of School Psychologists (NASP) 


WAGE:

The median annual wage for psychologists was \$81,500 in May 2022.
