SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS:

Identify, assess, diagnose, treat and help to prevent communication and swallowing disorders in children and adults; work with individuals who have problems with speech and language, including related cognitive or social communication problems



QUALIFICATIONS:

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- Master's degree in speech pathology
 - Nevada school districts – an educational license is required
 - National certification - Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC) awarded by ASHA
 - Passage of the PRAXIS examination in Speech Pathology


WAGE:

The median annual wage for speech-language pathologists was \$84,140 in May 2022.

SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS

SCHOOL-BASED:

Evaluate students for speech and language disorders and work with teachers and other school personnel and parents to develop and carry out individual or group programs, provide counseling, and support classroom activities
